 - (i) applications for authorities referred to it by the Director of Public Health; and
 - (ii) the issue of guidelines under section 56 [of the *Radiation Protection Act 2005*]; and
 - (iii) codes of practice.

NOTE: The Radiation Advisory Council meets (at least) 6 times each year. Members of the Council (other than members who are State Service officers or State Service employees) may be paid a fee currently set at \$177 per day.
