The Maggie Awards are awarded annually by Statewide Mental Health Services. The Maggie Awards recognise employees of Statewide Mental Health Services who have provided outstanding service.

Category: Clinical Excellence

The Clinical Excellence category recognises an SMHS clinical staff member who consistently demonstrates and encourages excellence in clinical practice, safety, and quality.

You should provide a brief explanation of who you are nominating, including the following:

- Examples of how they have demonstrated consistently demonstrates and encourages excellence in clinical practice, safety, and quality.
- What they have done to make things better for others.
- The period of time they have worked with SMHS (if known).
- Other awards or recognition received by the nominee.

The Selection Panel will seek to satisfy itself that the nominee has:

- demonstrated achievement and/or personal qualities at a high level.
- made a contribution over and above what might be reasonably expected through employment.
- contributed to SMHS in a manner that stands out from others, and their contribution has been valuable.

Please provide your nomination to SMHSMaggieAwards@ths.tas.gov.au. The nomination will then be kept in safekeeping until the short-listing phase.

Nominations will be shortlisted, and the shortlisted finalists will be contacted for details of (up to) four referees to support their nomination for an award and for a copy of their CV.
