Formal recognition of outstanding service

The Maggie Awards are awarded annually by Statewide Mental Health Services. The Maggie Awards recognise employees of Statewide Mental Health Services who have provided outstanding service.

Category: Lifetime Achievement

The Lifetime Achievement Award is presented in recognition of an individual's outstanding leadership and contribution to the mental health sector (either in SMHS or through other workplaces) for more than 20 years and through improving professional practice and who has sponsored or facilitated major change which has positively impacted the lives of mental health consumers.

You should provide a brief explanation of the staff member that you are nominating, including the following:

- Examples of how the Team have who have developed and implemented innovative quality activities to respond to complex issues and improve the consumer experience or outcomes.
- What they have done to make things better for others.
- The period of time they have worked with SMHS (if known).
- Other awards or recognition received by the nominee.

The Selection Panel will seek to satisfy itself that the nominee has:

- demonstrated achievement and/or personal qualities at a high level.
- made a contribution over and above what might be reasonably expected through employment.
- contributed to SMHS in a manner that stands out from others, and their contribution has been valuable.

Nominations will be shortlisted, and the shortlisted finalists will be contacted for details of (up to) four referees to support their nomination for an award and for a copy of their resume.





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
